We spent two night (January 13,14) with another couple in two rooms. The rooms were beautiful and the service was top notch.. We took advantage of an opening season mid-week special rate of \$99. You can find that rate if you look. Check-in was efficient , ski lockers were provided and we were in our rooms quickly. The staff was,helpful, friendly and a pleasure to deal with. The Lodge has fixed the bugs mentioned in previous reviews and then some - we couldn't have been more impressed.

We enjoyed the indoor pool with full length waterfall feature. There are two hot tubs (one indoor and one outdoor on a balcony, They both were properly hot with strong jets. The only problem here may be the relatively small size when the lodge is full with skiers back from the slopes.

We ate both dinner and breakfast at Leany's Steakhouse in the Lodge. The food was inovative and delicious, and the service couldn't have been better. We had planned to eat there once and go elsewhere the next night, but were so impressed that we came back the next night. Breakfasts were equally good and worth the price.

The Lift Bar and Patio looked spectacular with large open pit fires indoor and out. It had informal food and pool tables, but we didn't have time to spend there.

There is also a Spa, but again no time to use the services.

We have stayed in other facilities in Brian Head including the Cedar Breaks Resort and found this our beat experience in Brian Head.
